## National Day celebration in Geneva

His Excellency Mr. Mani Prasad Bhattarai, Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Nepal to the United Nations Office and other international organizations in Geneva, hosted a National Day reception on 20 September 2019 to celebrate the historic day for the commemoration of promulgation of the Constitution of Nepal in 2015.
- 2. In his remarks on the occasion, Ambassador Bhattarai conveyed the best wishes and warm greetings from The Rt. Hon. President Bidya Devi Bhandari and The Rt. Hon. Prime Minister K P Sharma Oli.
